PROCESS FOR THE GRADE 8 2024 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS

Scholarship Applications for Grade 8 2024 may be submitted as from Monday 30 January 2023.

The closing date to submit an application will be 17h00 Friday 03 March 2023.

Late applications will **NOT** be accepted.

MINIMUM CRITERIA WHICH MUST BE MET IN ORDER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR CONSIDERATION:

- **Academic Scholarships**: Academic achievement Candidates must have achieved a year end aggregate of <u>at least 80%</u> in Grade 6.
- Cultural Scholarships:
 - Music candidates need to play an instrument at Grade Three level.

 Drama/Choir or Art: Candidates must have achieved at Diploma level in a regional/national Eisteddfod (Pretoria Eisteddfod or National Eisteddfod) for at least the past 2 years.

 Dancing: Candidates must be a member of a dance studio and have participated in examinations for at least 3 years or have participated at Diploma level in a regional Eisteddfod or similar competition for at least the past 2 years.
- **Sport Scholarships**: Hockey, Cricket, Netball, Golf, Soccer, Athletics, Equestrian, Rugby, Swimming, Water Polo, Tennis, Squash, Basketball. Pupils should have been selected to district or provincial sides in the year of or the year preceding their application.
 - **Where necessary, the College may invite candidates for skills tests. This will be by invitation only.

Please note that satisfying the minimum criteria does NOT not imply that a scholarship will definitely be awarded.

All candidates - even those applying for only sport or only cultural scholarships must write the scholarship exams.

The scholarship examination will be written on the 2 dates listed below. Please select **one** day your child would be attending to write.

Saturday 18 March 2023 (07h30 to 09h30)

The following subjects will be assessed: **English and Mathematics** (60 minutes each).
